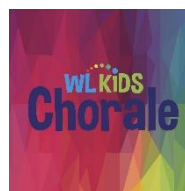
Upcoming Events

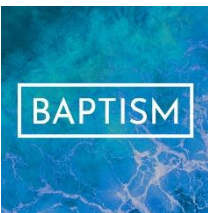
