

Backpacks for Jefferson

WL has an opportunity to continue being a good neighbor to Jefferson Elementary by helping to provide 100 backpacks for the new school year. This would be a great way for a Life Group, ABF, or individuals to bless and serve our community.

Each bag is color-coded for the school grade level and comes with a tag attached that lists the eight items needed to fill the bag. A bag can be filled for about \$25. Contents for each bag varies depending on the grade level, and includes items such as Crayola Crayons, pencils, glue, erasers, black and white composition notebook, and yellow post-it notes.

The bags may be picked up at the 2nd Wind/Jefferson Elementary ministry station in the entryway of the church (across from the Info center). Filled bags will need to be returned to the same location by Sunday, August 1.
